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Quincy After School Child Care, Inc. TUITION SCHOLARSHIP GRANT PROGRAM

Basic Information:

Tuition scholarship grants are made possible through funding provided by the City of Quincy Community Development Block Grant, as well as physically donated funds from other grants and private donations. The TSG awards help to offset weekly childcare tuition for low to moderate income, working families who are served by our program. Eligible guardians must be working 20+hrs per week or attending schooling equivalently, and have a need for after school childcare. (MA/PhD programs not eligible). Average grants are \$12 per day (dependent on available funding), with the remainder of tuition paid by the family. Families served by the state voucher system, or any other tuition offset are not eligible for tuition scholarship grants. Tuition scholarship grants are for the school year after school programs and are first come, first served. If additional funding remains, TSG is offered for vacation programs and participants will be notified.

Interested families must complete all sections of a scholarship application, reporting income from all sources for all guardians who support the child(ren) in the household, and must supply all required supporting documents. The application will be used by QCARE program administration to fairly evaluate family eligibility and will be maintained as part of the scholarship application for potential audit by grantors. Some data in this application is required for grant application purposes. It is the responsibility of the family to report any income status changes once a scholarship grant program. Additionally, all policies, procedures and rules of QCARE must be maintained, including on time tuition payments.

How to apply:

Please use the Federal HUD Income guidelines below to assess your family's eligibility before applying for a tuition scholarship grant. If your gross (pre-tax) total household income falls on this chart under your household size, you may qualify for a tuition scholarship.
